

What to bring for a wedding in Aruba

For brides and grooms, provide all of the following:

- Long-form birth certificates
- Negative statements of marriage
- Copy of passports or valid state-issued photo ids
- Letter of intent for bride and groom
- Single status report
- Divorce decrees, if applicable
- · Death certificates, if widowed

Requirements for witnesses:

- Two witnesses present at ceremony (Must be over the age of 18)
- Copy of birth certificate
- Either a copy of the passport photo page or a valid state-issued photo id
